The Bible says, *"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."* Romans 10:13

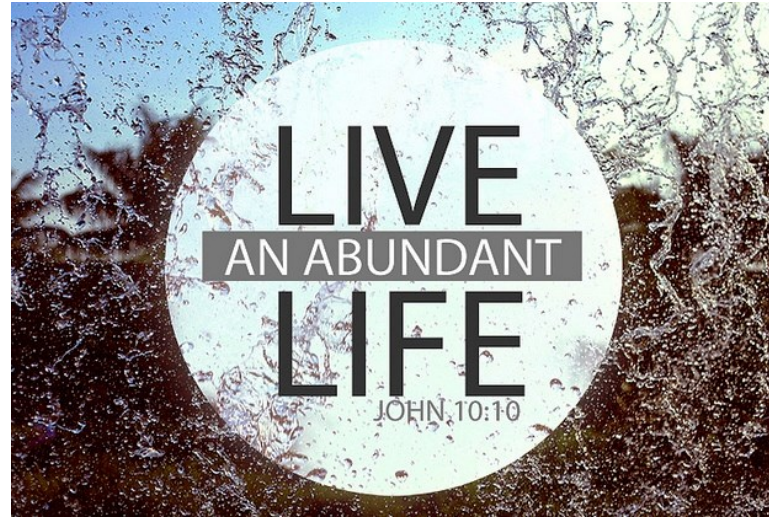
Receive Christ As Your Savior

We are in need of replacing the 1980's piano that the church has had for a number of years. It is not keeping a tune and is not adequate for the size of the auditorium. The Music Committee was asked to find a digital piano to recommend to the church. They searched and found a Roland HP 305 Digital Piano which normally runs \$4,800; however, we are able to purchase it for only \$3,000. It comes with a 5 year warranty. The Leadership Team is recommending we purchase the Roland for \$3,000 using funds from the gas royalty savings account. The vote will take place after the service on June 1. If you are a member and are not able to be here to vote, you can pick up an absentee ballot today and vote at the welcome center. If you use an absentee ballot please circle your name on the member list next to the ballots. You may also stop by the office this week. Absentee ballots must be returned to the church office by Friday, May 30 to be included in the vote.
